## NAP/AP1(a) FRENCH ARMY -

Suilable for Revolutionary Wars through to end of campaign in Egypt. Italian, Russian campaigns etc, Infantry dressed in Bicorn and Long Tailed Coat, Cavalry in Mirliton type Shako. (All Cavalry include horses).

### NAP/AP1(b) FRENCH ARMY ~

Suitable for the Egypt campaign. Infantry in Casquette and Pouf hat and Kleber ordinance tunic. Cavalry in Mirliton type shake Contents as NAP/AP1(a) except for dress of infantry as listed above.



Suitable for Peninsular War.



Many of the above cavalry may be used for the revolutionary wars (back to 1789) and for later years in the Napoleonic War.




FNG1(a) French 6" Howitzer complete with trail chest (with detachable lid) & sponge bucket


