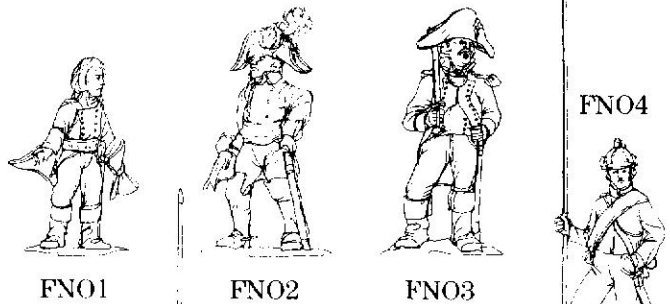
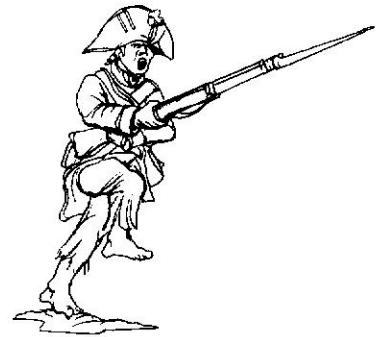


25mm NAPOLEONIC WARS

AT LONG LAST, a range of superbly animated and realistic looking 25mm Napoleonic figures. More character and variation than ever before! Many of the codes have head variations to relieve the boredom of painting and having to look at all the same figure in each of your units! A whole new era in Napoleonic wargaming!

Although aimed primarily at the Egyptian campaign many of these figures can be used back to the French REVOLUTION

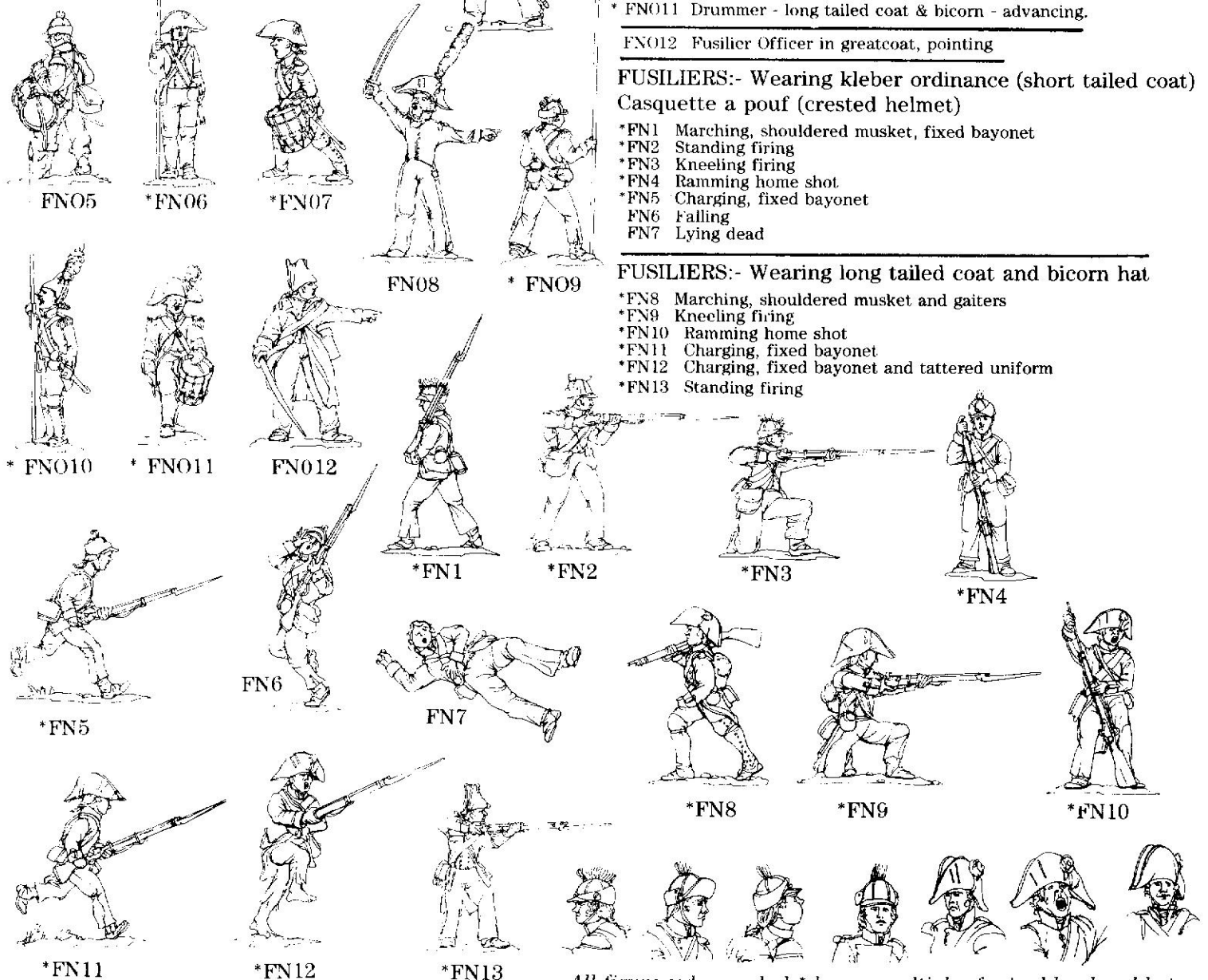

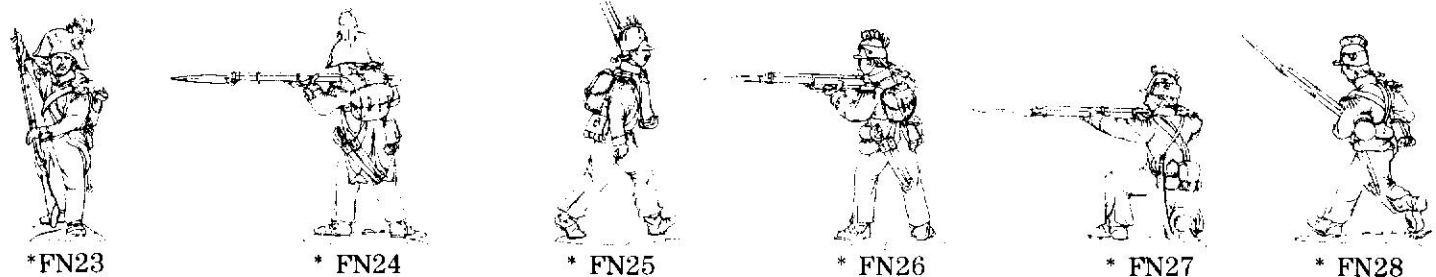

FRENCH NAPOLEONIC ARMIES - c 1789 - 1808

NAP/AP1(a) FRENCH ARMY -

Suitable for Revolutionary Wars through to end of campaign in Egypt. Italian, Russian campaigns etc.
Infantry dressed in Bicorn and Long Tailed Coat, Cavalry in Mirliton type Shako.
(All Cavalry include horses).



Contains:

- 1 Staff Officer
- 3 Mounted Officers
- 24 Cavalry
- 90 Infantry (inc. Officers and standard bearers)
- 2 6" Howitzers with crew

NAP/AP1(b) FRENCH ARMY -

Suitable for the Egypt campaign.
Infantry in Casquette and Pouf hat and Kleber ordinance tunic. Cavalry in Mirliton type shako.
Contents as NAP/AP1(a) except for dress of infantry as listed above.



NAP/AP1(c) FRENCH ARMY -

Suitable for Peninsular War.

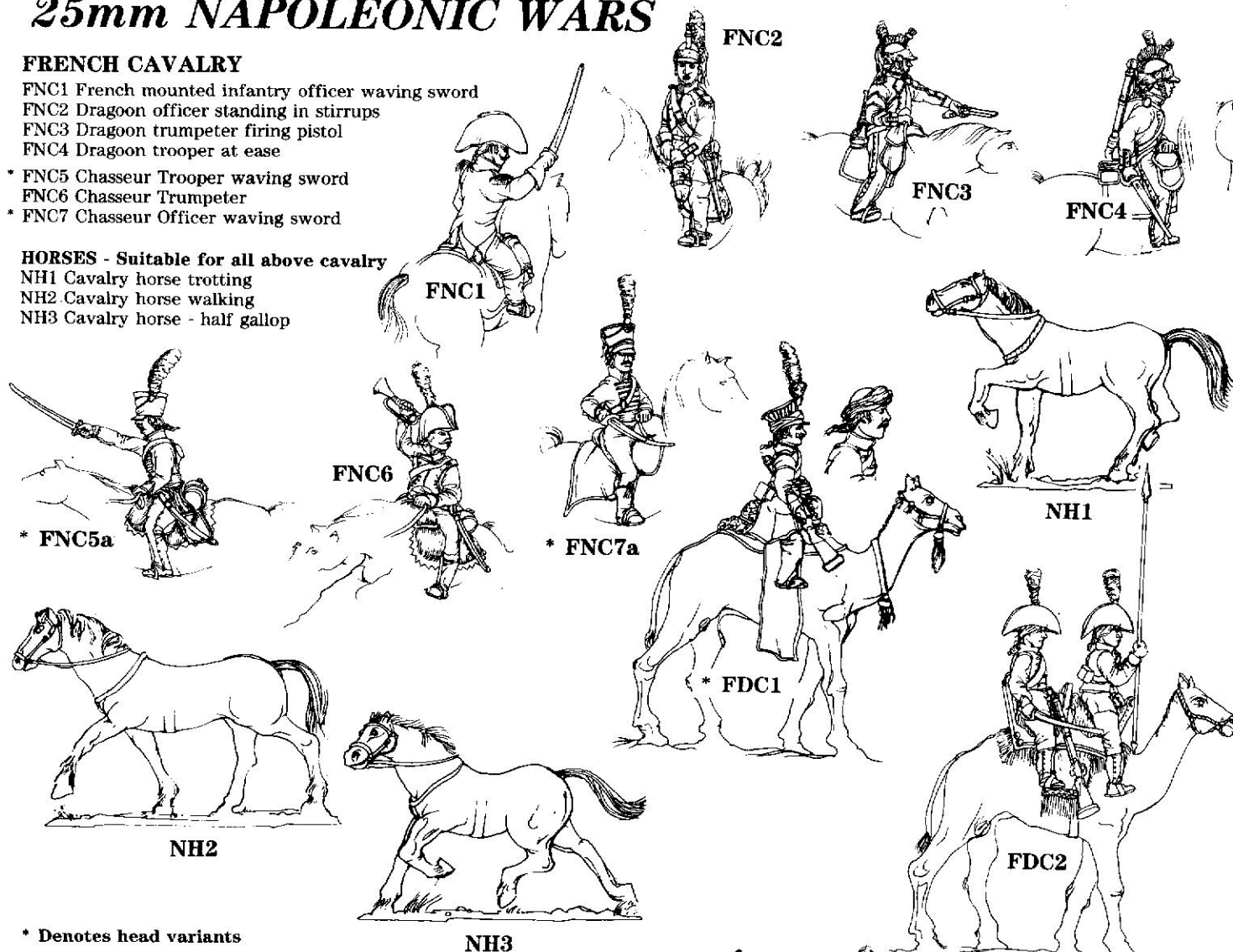
FRENCH CAVALRY

FNC1 French mounted infantry officer waving sword
FNC2 Dragoon officer standing in stirrups
FNC3 Dragoon trumpeter firing pistol
FNC4 Dragoon trooper at ease

* FNC5 Chasseur Trooper waving sword
* FNC6 Chasseur Trumpeter
* FNC7 Chasseur Officer waving sword

HORSES - Suitable for all above cavalry

NH1 Cavalry horse trotting
NH2 Cavalry horse walking
NH3 Cavalry horse - half gallop



FNC5+7 are supplied with a separate sword arm to enable the modeler to achieve different charging positions with the sword. These two figures can also be supplied with (a) Shako or (b) Mirliton. In the case of FNC7, Chasseur Officer, this can also be supplied with bicorn.

Many of the above cavalry may be used for the revolutionary wars (back to 1789) and for later years in the Napoleonic War.

FRENCH DROMEDARY CORPS

* FDC1 Single mount camel complete with rider (frock tunic). Choice of (a) plumed shako or (b) turban

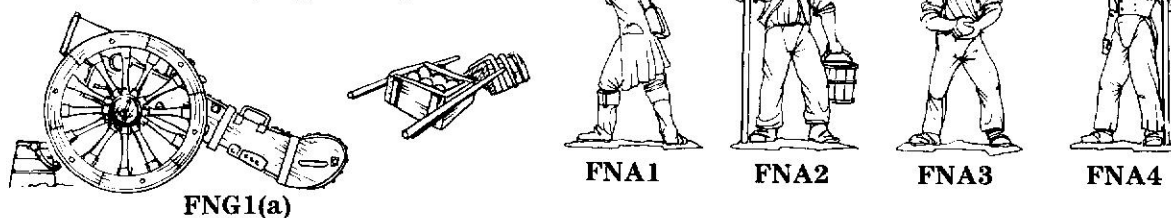
FDC2 Double mount camel complete with 2 riders in bicorn with interchangeable right arms (sword & lance)

FNG1(a) French 6" Howitzer complete with trail chest (with detachable lid) & sponge bucket

ARTILLERY CREW (No head variants)

FNA1 Officer, bicorn & frockcoat with telescope
FNA2 Artilleryman standing with sponge & bucket
FNA3 Artilleryman, bicorn, standing with shot
FNA4 Artilleryman, foragecap, standing with ramrod



THE PENINSULAR CAMPAIGNS - 1808-1814

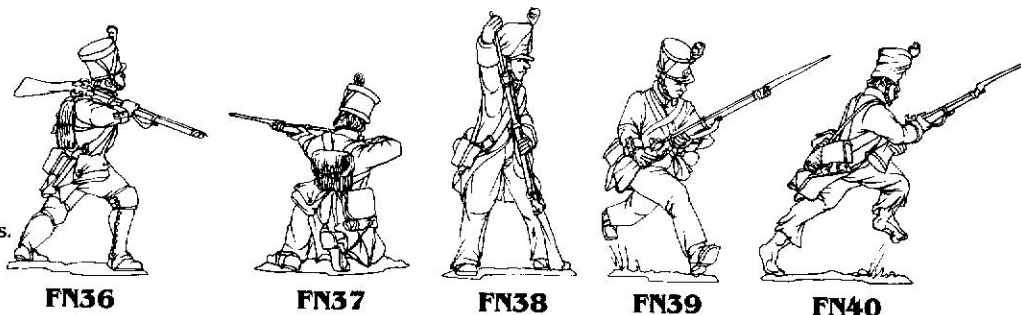
Carrying on from the 'French in Egypt' range this equally superb range of figures represents the troops of Napoleon's invasion of Spain from 1808 to 1814.

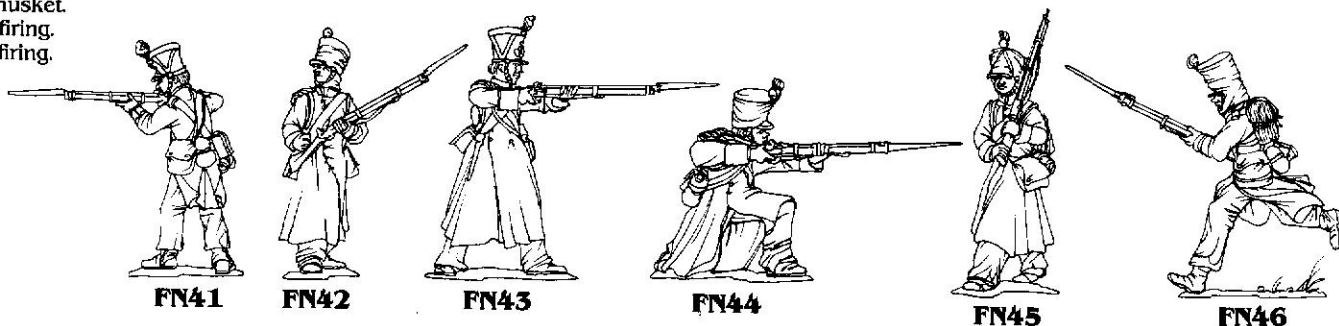

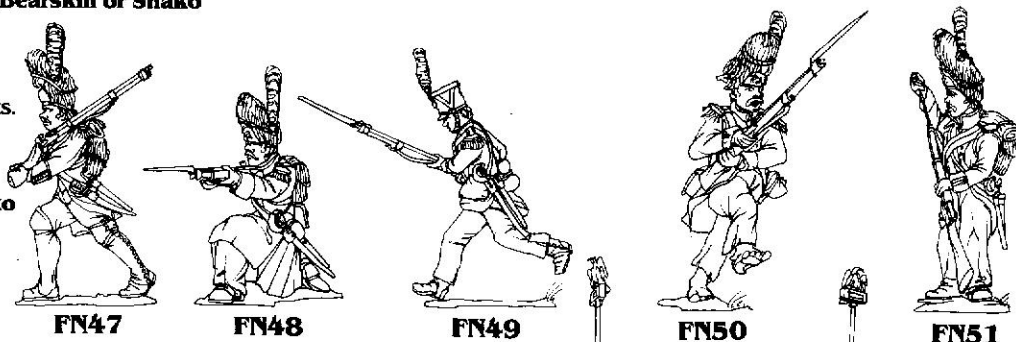

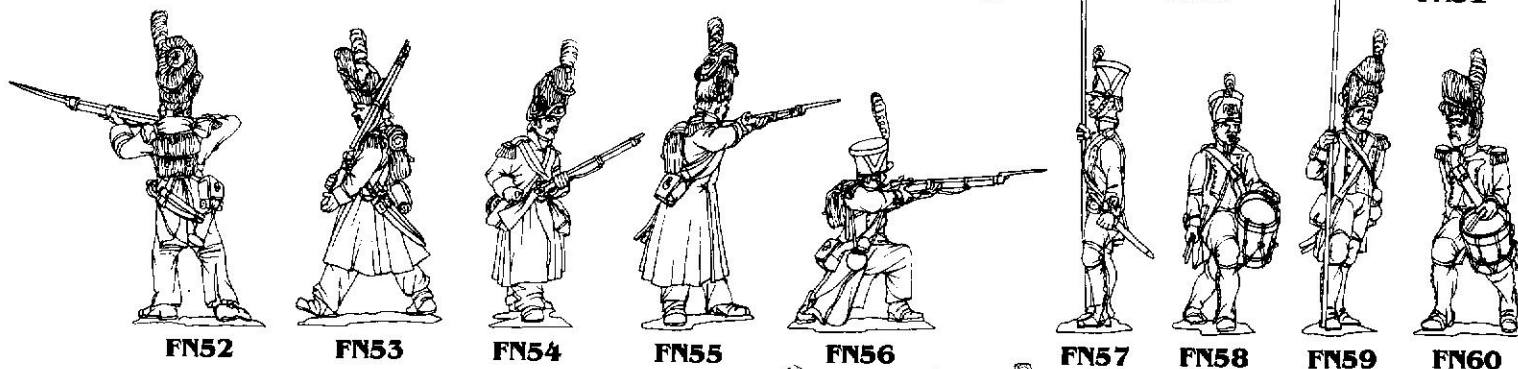

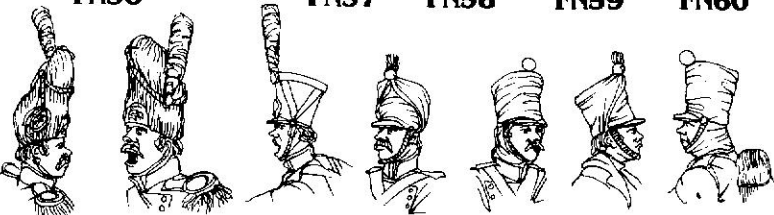

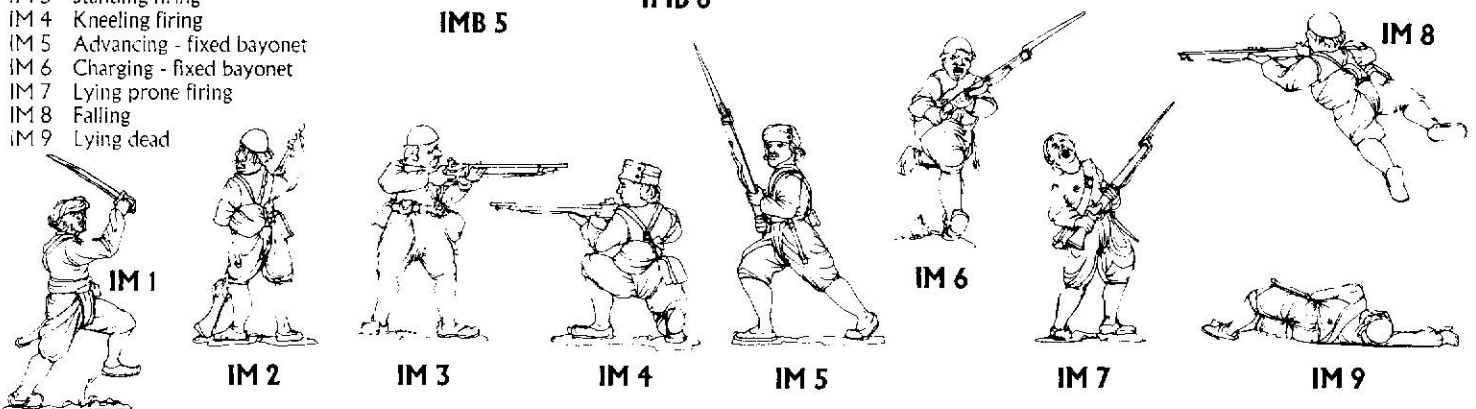
BRITISH INFANTRY - Short jackets (or shirts) tattered trousers and fixed bayonets.

MUTINEERS - Traditional costume
