

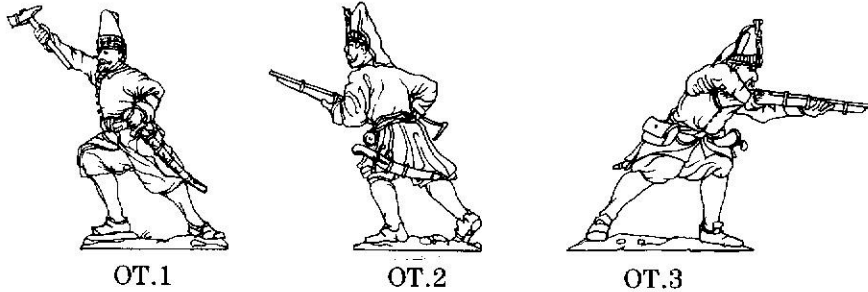
25mm Ottoman Turks

 OTH2 Light cavalry horse at fast trot.

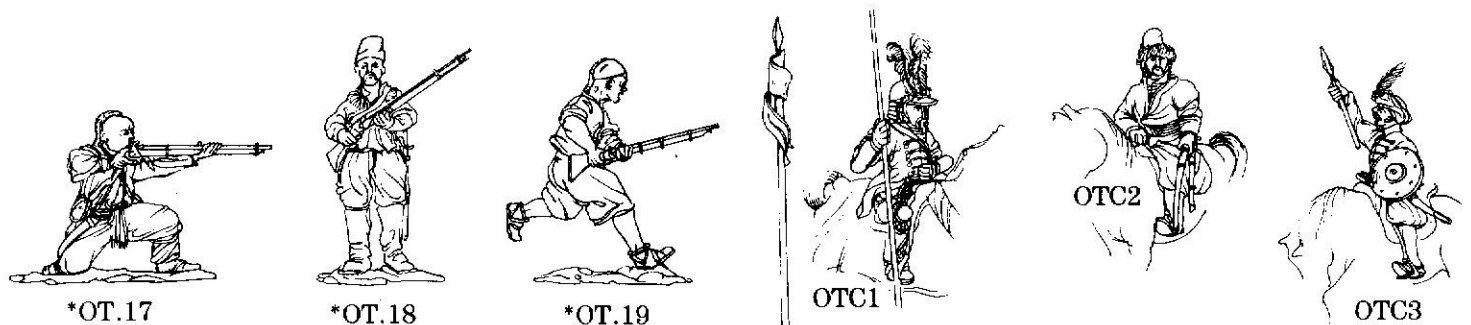
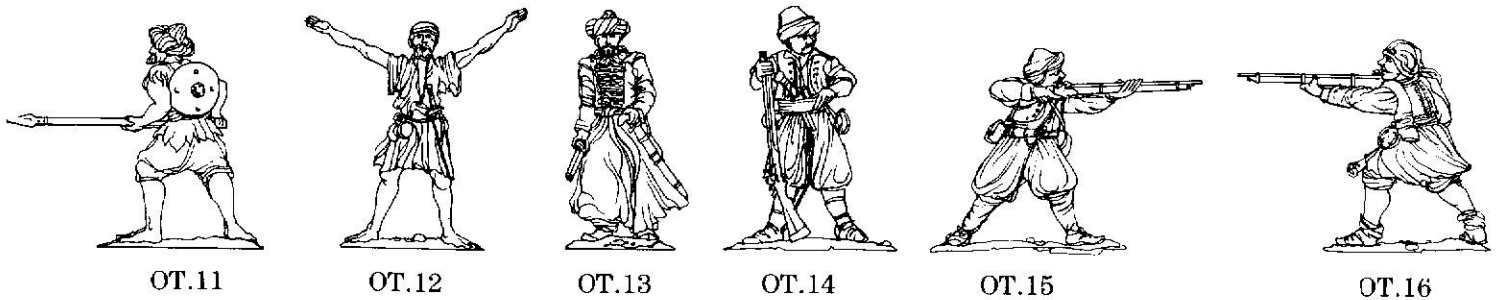
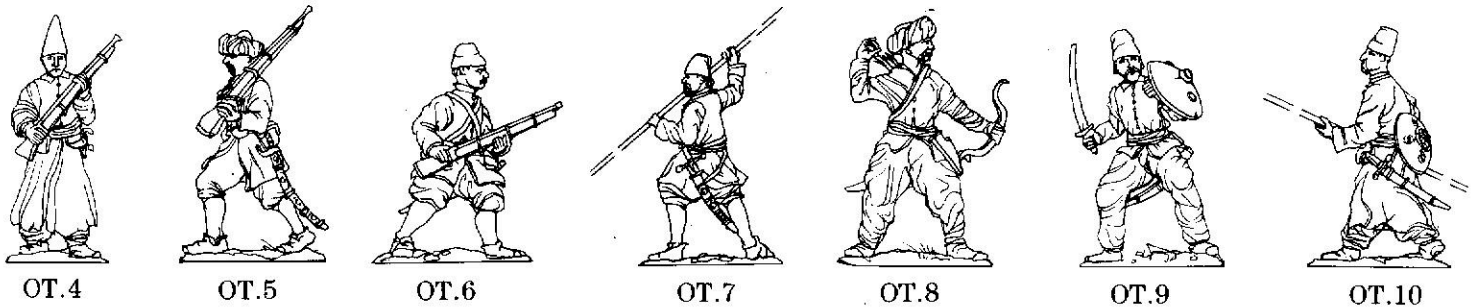


Figure Codes Marked * Have a Multiple of Mixed Head Variants
